If you are not able to meet the technology requirements in order to appear, you are required to advise the requesting attorney's office (identified below) not less than ten calendar days prior to the date and time when you are commanded to appear, to discuss alternate means of compliance with this subpoena.

The provisions of Fed. R. Civ. P. 45 (c), relating to your protection as a person subject to a

subpoena, and Fed. R. Civ. P. 45 (d) and (e), relating to your duty to respond to this subpoena and the potential consequences of not doing so, are attached.

If you fail to appear, this Subpoena may be enforced in Court.
